ICML can no longer accept 960 hours of work experience as a substitute for MLA I certification. This means that every MLA II candidate now must earn MLA I certification first...

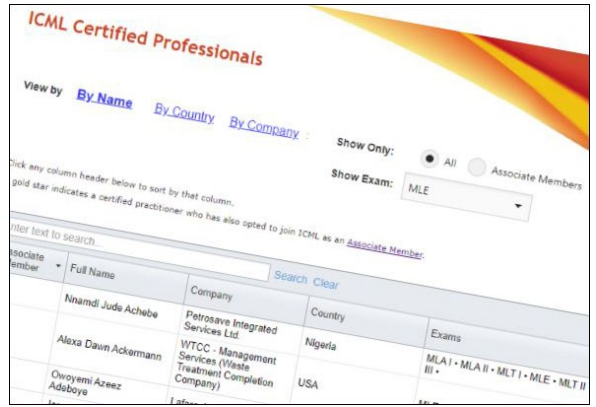

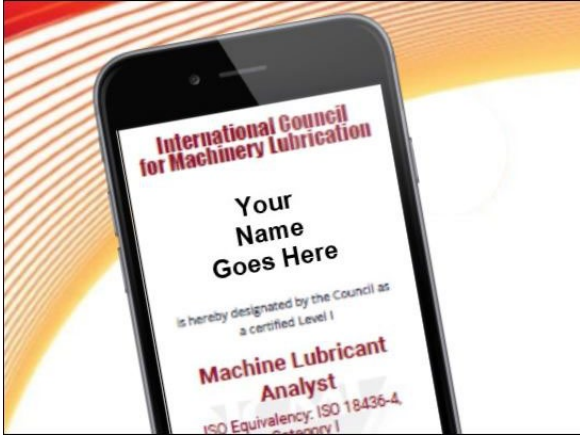
